Milford Graves was an employee of mine during the past two years.

Milford was responsible for setting up an entire clinical laboratory and in charge of the operation of that laboratory.


The facilities of the laboratory enabled:

1. Chemical studies of all clinically important serum chemical constituents and enzymes, thyroid hormones, and electrolytes and blood gases.
2. Quantitative bacteriological differentiation and sensitivity testing.
3. Hematology, including serology, Coombes testing and L.E. cell preparations.
4. Parasitological examinations of the blood and feces.

Milford devised special new micro methods for small feline samples and spent much of his own time studying to enable him to develop and perform these tests.
